Development Aid at a Glance

 *Development Aid at a Glance* is the newest addition to the OECD “at a glance” series, which gives accessible, informative overviews of today’s major issues. Using a clear, double-page format and colourful graphs and charts, this book presents key indicators along with explanatory text and references to give as complete a picture of possible of aid statistics. The book offers six regional reports - the World, Africa, America, Asia, Europe and Oceania - and will be of interest to anyone requiring a comprehensive snapshot of the development aid situation in the world today.

African Economic Outlook

 This fact-filled annual reference book brings the reader the latest available economic information for most of the economies of Africa, on a country-by-country comparative basis. Drawing on the expertise of both the African Development Bank and the OECD, the report consists of three main parts: an assessment of the position of Africa in the world economy, country studies on selected African countries and finally, a statistical annex. It provides the timely review of African countries’ economic situation and short-term prospects which are essential for informed economic development policy and decision-making.



The Development Dimension

The issue of development has become a key policy focus for OECD countries. The relationship between industrialised nations and the developing world is so complex – comprising linkages through trade, migration flows, and aid assistance, to name but a few – that it is difficult to know how to devise the most effective and coherent development policies. This wide-ranging book series covers different aspects of interdependency and policy coherence, in order to address this fundamental challenge while working towards the Millennium Development Goals.

The OECD Development Centre was created to be the interface between OECD Member and non-member countries, in order to bring together their knowledge and experience and address the specific needs of emerging and developing economies. International Development Statistics

International Development Statistics gives you access to four component databases related to the economic situation of developing countries and development aid activities. *Geographical Distribution of Financial Flows to Aid Recipients* contains comprehensive data on the volume, origin, and types of aid and other resource flows from donor countries and donor organisations to over 180 recipient countries, going back to 1960. External Debt Statistics provide detailed historical data on the gross external debt of developing countries, from 1975 to 2002. You will also obtain access to the OECD Development Assistance Committee (DAC)’s database and the Creditor Reporting System’s Aid Activities database.

OECD Journal on Development

 The *OECD Journal on Development* (formerly, *The DAC Journal*) brings together a unique record of recent development co-operation work undertaken by OECD’s Development Assistance Committee (DAC). There are four issues a year. The first issue of the year presents the OECD Development Co-operation Report, the DAC’s annual overview of development co-operation efforts and policies. Its statistical annex includes key official development assistance data. The other issues assemble individual DAC “Peer Reviews” - in-depth country reviews of each DAC member’s development co-operation policies and programmes - and a number of prominent, high-impact papers on development co-operation issues connected with the DAC’s work.
