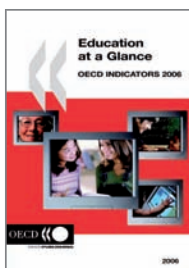

Education at a Glance



Across OECD countries, governments are seeking policies to make education more effective while searching for additional resources to meet increasing demand. This comprehensive annual report presents comparable statistical indicators and analysis on the performance of education systems in all OECD countries, as well as Brazil, Chile, Israel, and the Russian Federation. It is of interest to anybody wanting to assess their country's education system and see how it compares internationally, using the most reliable quantitative measurements currently available.



Education Policy Analysis

Improving the quality, equity and efficiency of education systems is a key policy objective in all OECD countries. *Education Policy Analysis* is a yearly publication which draws on international experiences to highlight the key education policy challenges and initiatives in OECD countries, and to offer lessons and recommendations for effective policy-making.

Schooling for Tomorrow

Schooling for Tomorrow is a forward-looking book series, dealing with emerging issues in the field of education. The series includes such titles as *Personalised Learning*, which explores the problems and opportunities in moving away from a "one size fits all" attitude to teaching, and *Think Scenarios, Rethink Education* which examines the benefits of applying scenario decision-making methods from other sectors to long-term planning in education.

Education Statistics

The *Education Statistics* database contains an up-to-date array of comparative education statistics and indicators from the 30 OECD countries and 24 non-OECD countries. It provides information on the human and financial resources invested in education, on access to education, on progression and completion of education, on how education and learning systems operate, and on the returns to educational investments. In addition, it includes access to the PISA database which presents the complete results and metadata for the Programme of International Student Assessment (see below for more information).

Knowledge Management

This series presents analytical reports on knowledge management from the Centre for Educational Research and Innovation (CERI). Recent reports have covered such topics as innovation in the knowledge economy, measuring knowledge management in the business sector, and new challenges for educational research.

Programme of International Student Assessment (PISA)



The Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA) is an international assessment of the skills and knowledge of 15-year olds, now involving around 60 countries. Taking place every three years, the survey aims to answer the questions of parents, students, educators and the public, regarding how well different national education systems prepare their students for the challenges of the future. The *PISA* book

series presents various studies and resources based on the findings of each survey. The *PISA* statistical database with the results for all the surveys is available as part of *Education Statistics*.

Students with Disabilities, Learning Difficulties and Disadvantages: Statistics and Indicators


This book provides an internationally comparable set of indicators on educational provision for students with disabilities, learning difficulties and disadvantages. It looks in detail at the students concerned, where they are educated (special schools, special classes or regular classes) and their level of education (pre-primary, primary, lower secondary and upper secondary education).
