

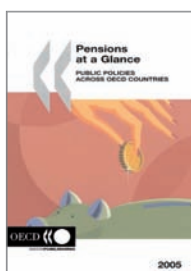

Pensions at a Glance



The first comprehensive book of its kind, this comparison of key features of pension systems of OECD countries provides coverage of retirement ages, benefit accrual rates, ceilings, and indexation. Future pension entitlements are shown for full-career workers at different income levels. Indicators measure redistribution in pension systems, the cost of countries' pension promises, and potential resource transfer. Thirty country chapters explain pension systems and replacement rates in detail. *Pensions at a Glance* has been named a "Notable Government Document" by the American Library Association.

International Direct Investments Statistics

Driven by technological change, global competition and the ongoing liberalisation of markets, international direct investment plays a key role in the process of global economic integration. This database gathers detailed historical statistics on international direct investment to and from the OECD area. Data are broken down by geographical zone and industrial sector for direct investment flows and stocks and date back as far as 1982.

Banking Statistics

This database provides information on financial statements of banks in all OECD member countries. The coverage of banks is not the same in each country, though the objective is to include all institutions which conduct ordinary banking business, namely institutions which primarily take deposits from the public at large and provide finance for a wide range of purposes. Some supplementary information on the number of reporting banks, their branches and staff is also included. Data are provided from 1979 onwards in national currencies for all OECD countries.

Insurance Statistics

The insurance industry is a major component of the economy by virtue of the amount of premiums it collects, the scale of its investment and, more fundamentally, the essential social and economic role it plays by covering personal and business risks. Data covered include: number of companies, number of employees, premiums by type of insurance, business written abroad, foreign and domestic investments, gross claims payments, gross operating expenses and commissions, OECD market share, penetration, density, and premiums per employee.

International Investment Perspectives

International Investment Perspectives is an annual report from the OECD which presents a detailed overview of recent trends and development in international investment, as well as chapters dealing with specific themes relevant to international investment. Recent topics covered include: foreign trade, competition, fiscal policy, and the OECD Policy Framework for Investment.



Investment Policy Reviews

Investment Policy Reviews is a book series which examines the policies of individual countries on foreign direct investment, and the role it plays in their economies. Countries covered include: China, the Russian Federation, Romania, Israel and Ukraine.

Financial Market Trends

Financial Market Trends is OECD's twice-yearly journal presenting timely analyses and statistics on financial matters of topical interest and longer-term developments in specific financial sectors. Each issue provides a brief update of trends and prospects in the international and major domestic financial markets. Topics that are regularly featured in this publication include: structural and regulatory developments in OECD financial systems; trends in foreign direct investment; and trends in privatisation.

Policy Issues in Insurance

This book series addresses major concerns of economic, political and social actors in the insurance sector, and covers a wide scope of regulatory and supervisory issues, such as: investment regulation, solvency assessment, management of insolvency, insurance contract law, mandatory insurance, reinsurance, taxation of insurance products, accountability, convergence in the financial services industry, policy holder protection, environmental risks, and emerging system risks.
