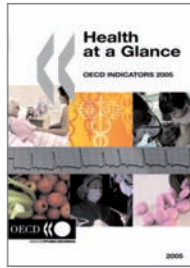

Health at a Glance

 *Health at a Glance* is an accessible overview of the situation of health and health systems in OECD countries. Updated annually, it provides the latest comparable data and trends regarding health status, health systems and non-medical determinants of health, as well as background information on the demographic and economic context. Over 30 indicators are clearly presented, illustrated by reader-friendly charts and graphs, and accompanied by succinct analysis, methodological notes, definitions and references for further reading.

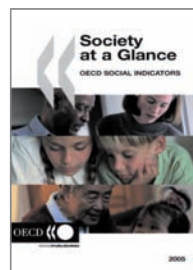
International Migration Statistics

The *OECD International Migration Statistics* database presents harmonised, comparable data on migration and stocks of foreign population, workers, and asylum seekers into and out of OECD countries, broken down by source country. The data are generally available from 1991 onwards.

Society at a Glance

 *Society at a Glance* is the OECD's biannual compendium of social indicators, covering topics such as employment, educational attainment, health, social equality, and social cohesion. It provides a statistical snapshot of social well-being in OECD countries, and allows users to analyse interlinked social issues in the context of a more complete representation of a country's social characteristics. As with other titles in the "at a glance" series, each

indicator is clearly presented using a reader-friendly mix of tables, graphs, analysis, contextual notes, and references for further reading.




Social Expenditure Statistics

The *OECD Social Expenditure Statistics* database has been developed in order to serve a growing need for indicators of social policy. It includes reliable, up-to-date and internationally comparable statistics on public and private social expenditure, going back to 1980. Data covered includes: old age benefits; disability benefits; services for the elderly and disabled; survivors' benefits; family cash benefits; unemployment benefits; public expenditure on health; public expenditure on housing; and other contingencies.

OECD Health Project

The *OECD Health Project* is an insightful book series which provides measurement and analysis to aid all those concerned with the major health policy challenges facing OECD economies today. It includes a wide variety of titles, covering the following main areas: health system performance and explanations for cross-country variations; new and emerging health-related technologies; long-term care for older people; and overall system assessment.

International Migration Outlook

 With increased population movement and developing labour shortages, migration has jumped up the policy agenda. The *International Migration Outlook* is an annual report on this core topic, covering migration and migration policy across OECD countries. It presents detailed data on the flows, the different channels of immigration, and the diversity of nationalities involved. It also examines the efforts of receiving countries to integrate immigrants into society and the labour market.


OECD Health Data

OECD Health Data offers the most comprehensive source of comparable statistics on health and health care economies of OECD countries available. This unique, interactive database is available online or on CD-ROM and is an essential tool for health researchers and policy advisors in governments, the private sector
