Monthly Statistics of International Trade



This reliable and up-to-date source of data on trade flows between OECD countries and their trading partners provides detailed insight into the most recent trends in world trading patterns. Data are broken down by economic groupings, by country and region, including seasonally adjusted series and calculated indicators. The monthly publication is divided into four parts: aggregate trade indicators, volume and average value indices, trade by SITC sections, and foreign trade of OECD countries by partner country. The online database provides longer time series, going back to 1960 and more than 80 partner countries and regions are included in the data coverage.

International Trade by Commodity Statistics



This vast database is a unique and reliable source of yearly statistical data on imports and exports of OECD countries and selected non-OECD countries, as well as of the OECD main country groupings. It provides detailed data in value, and in some cases quantity, broken down by partner country and commodity. *International Trade by Commodity Statistics* is also available as a printed annual publication in five volumes, the first four containing tables for individual countries, and the final volume providing data for regional groupings.

Export Credit Financing Systems



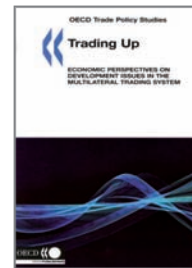

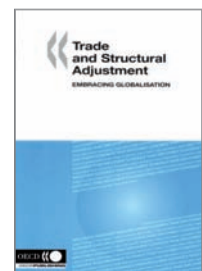
Trading Up: Economic Perspectives on Development Issues in the Multilateral Trading System
